### *Your contribution:*

- attending an English-only B. Sc. or M. Sc. programme at Technische Hochschule Augsburg (THA) **or** Universität Augsburg (UA)
- high motivation to improve your German-speaking ability
- excellent progress within your above mentioned programme

### *Our grant covers:*

- we cover a maximum of 75% or 600 € of the course fee
- funding of a German language course (up to target level B2) of your choice, or
- funding of any other reasonable integration activity.

### *Application deadline:*

- at least six weeks ahead of the start of the course you apply for

### *Documents: a single PDF containing (submit to [antrag@faust-augsburg.de](mailto:antrag@faust-augsburg.de), please)*

- your motivation letter (max. 1 page); in particular, as we are not inclined to support language courses which are similar to courses offered by the respective language centres (THA, UA), please confirm (i) that you have sought language counselling at the language centre relevant for you, and (ii) that there are no courses satisfying your needs, and why.
- details about your proposed (German language) course
- your CV, including a copy/photo of your „Aufenthaltstitel“ (residence permit)
- proof of excellent progress in your programme (e.g., current Transcript of Records, or recommendation letter from a lecturer/professor)
- a description of your financial situation (including, in particular, a short synopsis of your monthly income/expenses)

We strongly recommend, before submitting your Integration Scholarship application, that you discuss your situation either with Adrian Bieniec (International Office, THA) or Birgit Kirchner (Akademisches Auslandsamt, UA).
