

WeltWeit Study Scholarship

The WeltWeit Study Scholarship partially finances the first exchange semester **for two outstanding applicants** within the exchange program WeltWeit.

The scholarship will be awarded each semester to two out of approx. 45 applicants for the WeltWeit program.

Recipient's obligation

The scholarship honors outstanding achievement and academic performance of the recipient.

During the covered period the student must

- support the International Office at events (e.g. Cultural Nights)
- take part in a feedback meeting with the WeltWeit team,
- write a testimonial, which will be published on the WeltWeit website.

Amount of scholarship

The scholarship amounts to 2,400 €. It will be paid out after the arrival in Augsburg in four monthly installments of 600 € each.

Requirements and applicant's profile

The scholarship is intended exclusively for applicants of the exchange program WeltWeit.

Good chances of receiving the scholarship have those applicants, who:

- hand in an outstanding application for the exchange program WeltWeit,
- can show excellent academic performance.

Application documents

A separate application for the scholarship is not required. The scholarship will be awarded based on the application documents (motivational letter and transcript of records) that are handed in for the exchange program. **Please note: The transcript must include a grading scale and a GPA. Otherwise, the application will not be considered for the scholarship.**

Deadlines

Since the selection of the scholarship recipients is based on the application for the exchange program WeltWeit, the exchange program's application deadlines apply: **April 30** for the winter semester / **November 10** for the summer semester.

Announcement of the scholarship recipients: until May 31 for the winter semester / until December 15 for the summer semester.

FAQs

- Each semester only **two** scholarships are awarded.
- Participants can **only receive one of two WeltWeit Scholarships**, therefore funding is limited to one semester.
