What is Open Access?

"By "open access" to [peer-reviewed research literature], we mean its **free** availability on the **public** internet, permitting any users to **read**, **download**, **copy**, **distribute**, **print**, search, or link to the full texts of these articles, crawl them for indexing, pass them as data to software, or **use** them for any other lawful purpose, without financial, legal, or technical barriers other than those inseparable from gaining access to the internet itself."

Overview: the three most common Open Access colours

Diamond / Platinum:

- "Free in, free out."
- no charges to authors or readers
- subsidised by organisations
- e.g. publication via a repository

Green:

- self-archiving in an institutional or subject repository
- usually the post-print
- embargoes apply

Gold:

- immediate, publisher's version
- payment of an article processing charge (APC)
- OA licence
- pure OA journals
- hybrid OA journals





How can you publish Open Access free of charge or subsidised?



- Diamond Open Access journals can be found in the DOAJ:
 - <u>https://doaj.org/</u>
- UniA "read & publish" agreements with publishers:
 - e.g. Wiley and Springer DEAL
 - articles in hybrid journals can be published Open Access free of charge
 - articles in fully gold journals can be published Open Access with a 20% discount
 - any remaining publishing costs need to be covered by the author or research group (subsidies may be available)

"Best of both worlds": OA with print on demand versions for book shops

- OA publication in the institutional repository, OPUS
- cooperation with an external partner, PubliQation additional services at discounted rates, such as
 - layout & design
 - copy editing
 - ebook formats
 - print on demand with ISBN for online book shops
 - own set of print copies
 - costs from ca. 500 E plus MwSt.

- DFG publication fund
 - pure gold OA journals
 - corresponding author at UniA
- 2. Young researchers fund
 - authors from the "Mittelbau" (research assistants / associates)
- Fund for the advancement of women
- ⁸ Pilot project 2022/2023
- 3, first come, first served basis

- Publisher agreements
- DEAL with Wiley and Springer
- PubliQation
- Subsidies via DFG, "young researchers" fund and funding for the advancement of women

Open Access Myth? Busted!

If all journals changed to pure gold (not hybrid), current subscription budgets could be used for gold OA. Desirable is a model where the journal is financed as a whole and not the individual article.


"The ,author pays' model is not sustainable long term. It can also lead to conflicts when sharing / dividing budgets and can cause problems for authors without affiliation to an academic institution."
