Erasmus+ at the University of Augsburg

Each academic year more than 150 students from around 20 European countries spend one or two semesters at the University of Augsburg through the Erasmus+ Incoming program.

Due to ever-growing attractive opportunities abroad, participating in an exchange semester is becoming more popular.




Accommodation
