### City Tour Augsburg



Founded around 0 BC by the Roman Emperor Augustus, Augsburg is one of the oldest cities in Germany. From the water management system, which was granted UNESCO World Heritage status in 2019, to the oldest existing social housing complex in the world, the Fuggerei: Our guided tour will cover all of Augsburg's highlights!

### Christmas City Tour Augsburg



The Christmas market in Augsburg is one of the oldest in Germany, dating back to the 15<sup>th</sup> century.
