- Our courses are aimed exclusively at students who are enrolled at the University of Augsburg and whose native language is not German.
- Participation in our German language courses is free of charge.
- We also recommend participation in our German language courses to those students who already proved German language skills at level B2 or C1 at the time of enrolment, but who would like to continuously improve their German level during the course of their studies.
- You can participate in German language courses even if no ECTS credits are awarded for your degree programme.

1. Courses

- We offer 2-hour and 4-hour courses. For 4-hour courses, please make sure that you are available for both weekly meeting times.
- In order to earn credit points for a course, you need to pass the final exam.

1. Courses

Information for exchange students

Your home university will usually specify a minimum number of ECTS points to be earned during your exchange stay. Please be aware that this minimum number cannot normally be earned by taking only German language courses. In order to earn the number of ECTS points required by your home university, please make sure you also attend classes in your field of studies.

You can earn a maximum of the following number of ECTS points in German language courses per level and semester:

A1: a maximum of 12 ECTS points
A2: a maximum of 12 ECTS points
B1: a maximum of 18 ECTS points

B2: a maximum of 27 ECTS points
C1: a maximum of 30 ECTS points
C2: a maximum of 6 ECTS points

Please do not attempt to maximise the number of ECTS points by choosing language classes at a higher or lower level than your competency in German.

Course registration via digicampus using your „RZ-Benutzerkennung“ (student login) and your password

Digicampus is an interactive tool for the organisation of your studies. You will use it to register for almost all courses, seminars and lectures, including language courses. You will also receive relevant information on the courses there.



3. Course Registration

Registration period:

Tuesday, October 06, 2026, 14:00 h until Friday, October 09, 2026, 14:00 h

→ Course places will be assigned on Friday, October 09, 2026, 15:00 h

- Course places are allocated at random.
- Please register only for courses in which you would like to participate.
- Please do not register for courses at different levels, especially when it comes to courses with similar content, but on different levels, e.g. you have to choose between „B1: Hörverständnis“ OR „B2: Hörverständnis“.
- We strongly recommend you participate in the courses you have chosen on a regular basis.
