What are OER?


UNESCO 2012 – 1. OER World Congress:

"Open Educational Resources (OERs) are any type of educational materials released into the public domain or with an open license that allows a user to freely obtain, copy, use, adapt, and re-share the materials. The "open" nature of the materials presents UNESCO Member States with powerful opportunity to increase the increase the quality and access to education as well as facilitate policy dialogue, knowledge sharing and capacity-building."



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How do OER "work"? Or: The OER Cycle

The 5 Rs of Using OER

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Reuse: Content can be reused in its unaltered form

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
What distinguishes OER?

- **1. Open access:** low-threshold (online)
- 2. Free of charge/free of cost: no compulsion / exclusion criterion ("Open" not equal to "Free"), however usually they are free of charge
- **3. Open file formats:** no formats bound to paid programs (e.g. HTML, ODF, RTF, SVG) changes possible (e.g. no PDF or similar)
