
What is special about the program?

- Strong research orientation: The teaching concept strongly mirrors the process of empirical research. Students not only discuss, but also produce empirical evidence on the conditions, processes, and effects of learning and instruction
- Interdisciplinary focus: The courses take psychological and educational perspectives on learning and instruction. In addition, perspectives from various subject matter didactics and media didactics are included.
- Internationalization: The students are encouraged to travel to international conferences and to go for research stays abroad.
- Intensive guidance: Students' research projects are closely supervised by the instructors, , with an excellent instructor-to-student ratio. There are also plenty of opportunities for interaction and discussion outside of the boundaries of the courses.
- Innovative course formats: The students receive plenty of high-level learning opportunities in authentic contexts.

How can I apply for the program?

Two-step application process:

- Step 1: Written application
- Step 2 (if necessary): Oral interview

Requirements:

Degree from a Teacher Education or Bachelor's programme related to research on learning and instruction

(e.g., BSc Psychology, BA Educational Science, BA Communication Science...)

- Theoretical, domain-specific knowledge
 (e.g., theories of learning and instruction, motivational theories, teaching and learning with media, heterogeneous learning
 prerequisites, technology-supported assessment and faciliation of learning and teaching)
- Methodological knowledge and skills
 (data collection and data analysis, foundations of diagnostics, basic statistics)
- English language proficiency (B2), German language proficiency (A2)
