Fees / Grants:

There are no participation fees. Students from abroad receive a flat rate of minimum €330 from the University of Augsburg as support. The exact amount depends on your home country. Approximately €170.00 of this are for accommodation including breakfast. The remaining amount will be refunded to you after the Summer School.

Breaks / Food / Drinks:

Food and drinks will be provided according to the agenda (marked with *). Lunch will be served for our guest students in the university cafeteria. In case of workshop excursions, participants may also opt for a packed lunch. Especially for the barbecue on opening day, please let us know whether you eat meat or follow a vegetarian or vegan meal plan.

Public Transport:

Augsburg Public transport is also included. The discounted weekly pass for our guests students will be distributed at the Augsburg Youth hostel on Monday evening by the Summer School organizers, so you can use it right away for your trip to the university. For your first tram ride from Augsburg Central Station to the Augsburg Youth Hostel on arrival day you have to pay (price: 2,10€). The nearest stops to the Hostel are "Barfüßerbrücke" and "Pilgerhausstraße".
