Welcome to the Medical Library

Augsburg University Library offers a growing stock of printed and electronic resources for medical research and education. The Medical Library is located in the teaching building of the Medical Faculty in the former paediatric clinic.

Using the library

Registration

Your library card allows you to order and borrow media from Augsburg University Library, use electronic resources, and order articles that are not available at Augsburg University.

Academic employees of the university

The CAMPUS CARD of Augsburg University can be activated to act as a library card. To do so, please fill out the library's [online registration form](#) and send us your library ID (number on your CAMPUS CARD following "Bibliothek:").

Please fill out the library's [online registration form](#). Please enter "UKA" in the field "Fakultät/Lehrstuhl bzw. Einrichtung:" and your UKA email address in the field "Email-Adresse dienstlich:".

Journal articles and books

Which journals are available online?

You can search for journals and check whether they are available at Augsburg University via the [Electronic Journals Library \(EZB\)](#).

The availability is indicated by the following traffic light colours:

The journal is

... **green**: freely accessible

... **yellow**: available on campus of Augsburg University and via the university network

... **red**: not available at Augsburg University

Ordering journal articles

Journal articles that are not available at Augsburg University can be ordered via the [document delivery service dokmed](#).

If possible, we deliver articles electronically. Expenses for the service are centrally covered.

Alternatively, articles and books can be ordered via interlibrary loan free of charge.

Finding books

You can either browse directly at the bookshelves in the library, or you can search for a book via the [online catalogue \(OPAC\)](#).

The catalogue will show you where a book is located, whether it has been borrowed, and whether it can be reserved. E-books can also be found via the online catalogue.

Printed medical books and journals are assigned the following shelfmarks:

900: Reference collection in the Medical Library, can be borrowed by employees

172: Textbook collection in the Medical Library, can be borrowed only by students

90: UKA stocks, please contact us in advance to view these stocks.

Recommending book purchases

Library introductions

We will gladly support you with questions on finding and accessing reading materials, e.g., via PubMed, the Cochrane Library, UpToDate, and study registers. Additionally, we offer support on reference management with EndNote and Citavi.

Publishing - OPUS Augsburg

Augsburg University's institutional repository, OPUS, allows you to publish your works online. Additionally, it serves as the university bibliography and is the basis for creating publication lists for the university's website.
