

# Dormitories for Exchange Students

## Dormitory *Lechbrücke* (Lechhauser Straße 35)

- **Rent:** 230 € (including internet)
- **Location:** see map on page 3
- **Distance from the university:** by bike: 23 mins, by tram: 25 mins  
**Distance from the city center:** by bike: 7 mins, by tram: 7 mins
- **Noteworthy features:** rooftop terrace on the 19<sup>th</sup> floor which has a view of the whole city, tram stop in front of the building, close to the city center, many international students
- **Drawbacks:** long distance to the university

## Dormitory *Göggingen* (Franzensbadstraße 4/4a and Römerstädter Straße 3)

- **Rent:** 192 € (including internet)
- **Location:** see map on page 3
- **Distance from the university:** by bike: 8 mins, by bus: 10 mins  
**Distance from the city center:** by bike: 16 mins, by bus: 22 mins
- **Noteworthy features:** lowest-priced dormitory, many international students, short way to the university
- **Drawbacks:** oldest dormitory, far away from the city center, bad transport connection to the university

- **Rent:** 201 € (including internet)
- **Location:** see map on page 3
- **Distance from the university:** by foot: 4 minutes  
**Distance from the city center:** by bike: 17 mins, by tram: 15 mins
- **Noteworthy features:** directly next to the university and tram stop
- **Drawbacks:** not a high chance of getting an apartment here, far away from the city center

### Dormitory *Prinz-Karl-Viertel* (Ernst-Lehner-Straße 8)

- **Rent:** 266 € (including internet)
- **Location:** see map on page 3
- **Distance from the university:** by bike: 11 mins, by bus or by tram: 15 mins  
**Distance from the city center:** by bike: 8 mins, by bus: 10 mins, by tram: 15 mins
- **Noteworthy features:** 3 rooftop terraces, in between two train stations, same distance to the university as it is to the city center
- **Drawbacks:** longer walk to the tram stop, bus comes once every 15 mins



### Dormitory *Bürgermeister-Ulrich-Straße* (Bürgermeister-Ulrich-Straße 142-150)

- **Rent:** 269 € (including internet)
- **Location:** see map on page 3
- **Distance from university:** by bike: 6 mins, by tram: 7 mins  
**Distance from city center:** by bike: 20 mins, by tram: 18 mins
- **Noteworthy features:** newest dormitory, tram stop directly in front of the building
- **Drawbacks:** far away from the city center
