Nomination and Application Process

Nomination	Partner institutions are welcome to submit nominations via EWP. If the partner university is not yet ready to nominate via EWP, they must nominate their students via the online nomination form in <u>Mobility-Online</u>. Instructions and login details are sent to partners via email at the beginning of each nomination period. Nomination period for winter semester 2026/27 or full year 2026/27: • 1 April – 15 May 2026 Nomination period for summer semester 2027: • 1 October – 15 November 2026
Application	Nominated students receive an email with the online application link and further instructions for admission and will then have to upload the following <u>application documents</u> in Mobility-Online: • Photo • ID or passport • CV in English (or German) • Transcript of Records in English (or German) • Language Certificate for German and/or English B2 level (not older than 2 years!) Deadline: 31 May 2026 (winter semester or full year) Deadline: 30 November 2026 (summer semester)

Academic Information

Language requirements	Erasmus incoming students must submit a language certificate in German or English. • for studying in German: German B2 - or • for studying in English: English B2 Please note that the offer in English is limited in some subject areas. Therefore, students who will only take modules in English must check whether they can find enough English-taught courses to fulfil their home university's credit requirements. Basic German skills are highly recommended for daily life, even if students only study in English.
Module Offer	Exchange students must choose their modules from the module catalogues for exchange students: https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/kursangebot/ They are allowed to take modules at the faculty of the respective inter-institutional agreement. In addition, they may take modules from a second faculty if required by their degree programme and approved by the University of Augsburg during the application process. Language and intercultural courses are open to all exchange students. Exchange students must fulfil the academic and language requirements of the respective module.

Workload	Exchange students are expected to do coursework at the University of Augsburg. Please note that it is not possible to supervise any bachelor, master or PhD theses of Erasmus exchange students or award ECTS for independent research.

	The standard semester workload is 30 ECTS, however, exchange students are flexible and are not required to take a certain number of ECTS by the University of Augsburg. Students should discuss with their home university how many ECTS are expected.
Learning Agreement	Learning Agreements must be submitted digitally via EWP. We prefer students to submit their learning agreements in September (winter semester) or March (summer semester) when the course offer for the semester of the exchange is definite and there are therefore fewer changes necessary. However, if required by the partner university, students may submit their Learning Agreements earlier.
Transcript of Records	Transcripts of Records only show the modules passed by the student. The document can be downloaded as a verifiable PDF by the student until 31 March (winter semester) or until 30 September (summer semester) from the University of Augsburg's examinations platform. The home university can verify the authenticity of the Transcript of Records via a dedicated verification website. Hard copies are no longer provided.

Practical Information

Housing	The International Office recommends that exchange students apply for an apartment in the student dormitories of the "Studierendenwerk": https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/dormitories_exchange/ Please note that we cannot guarantee a dormitory apartment for every Erasmus student, but usually all or almost all students receive an apartment offer. If preferred, students can live in private accommodation, but please note that the International Office can only offer limited support in finding such private accommodation.
Visa and Residence Permit	EU citizens do not need to apply for visa. Non-EU citizens usually have to apply for a student visa. Non-EU citizens who have a valid residence permit from another EU state may be eligible to come under the REST directive without the need for a visa. https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/erasmus/visa-and-residence-issues/
Health Insurance	All EU students need to have a valid European health insurance card (EHIC) to be enrolled at the University of Augsburg. All non-EU students have to take out German public health insurance or proof of a private health insurance that is considered equivalent to German public health insurance to be enrolled. https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/erasmus/health-insurance/
Special Needs	Please indicate in your nomination if a student has special needs or is entitled to exam accommodations. We will then check how we can best address their individual needs.
Fees	There are no tuition fees for exchange students. Semester contribution of currently 181,95 EUR is mandatory to be enrolled at the University of Augsburg. This includes the students' semester travel tickets and other student services.
Orientation Programme	Each semester, an orientation programme is organised by the International Office in cooperation with ESN (Erasmus Student Network) before the start of lectures. Details will be provided by the International Office to all nominated students. It is required that students arrive in time for the orientation programme.
Buddy Programme	Each Erasmus student is allocated a buddy at the University of Augsburg. Buddies are University of Augsburg students who volunteer to support incoming students during their time in Augsburg (support in practical matters, help finding their way around campus etc..)
